Directions to Buford's Massacre Site (Located 9 miles East of Lancaster, SC)

From Columbia:

- 1) Take I-77 North to Lancaster Highway/Highway 9 Exit (approximately 50 miles)
- 2) Take Exit and proceed East on Lancaster Highway/Highway 9 to Lancaster
- 3) Continue on Highway 9 from the Hwy 9/Hwy 521 Bypass once past Lancaster
- 4) Proceed approximately 7.5 miles to Buford's Crossroads
- 5) Turn Right (South) onto Highway 522/Rocky River Road
- 6) Proceed approximately 300 yards
- 7) Turn Right into gravel lot

From Charlotte:

- 1) Take I-77 South to the Lancaster Highway/Highway 9 Exit
(approximately 30 miles from I-485)
- 2) Follow directions for "From Columbia" starting at Step 2
