Units are urged to bring their color guards, to wear period uniforms, and to bring chapter and State flags.

Historian Compatriots Jeff Bright and Stewart Dunaway will present a program of important recently-discovered facts concerning the ***Battle of Clapp's Mill*** and display a diorama of the battle. Stewart Dunaway's new book "***The Battle of Clapp's Mill***" will be available for sale.

There will be a living history and encampment on Saturday and Sunday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. daily May 16th -- 18th at the park.
